FASD CAUSES LIFELONG DISABILITIES

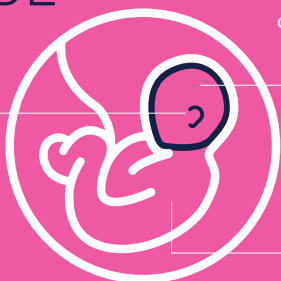

Facial distinctions – low set ears

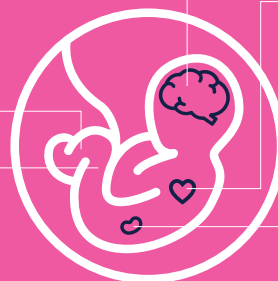


Small head circumference

Limb damage

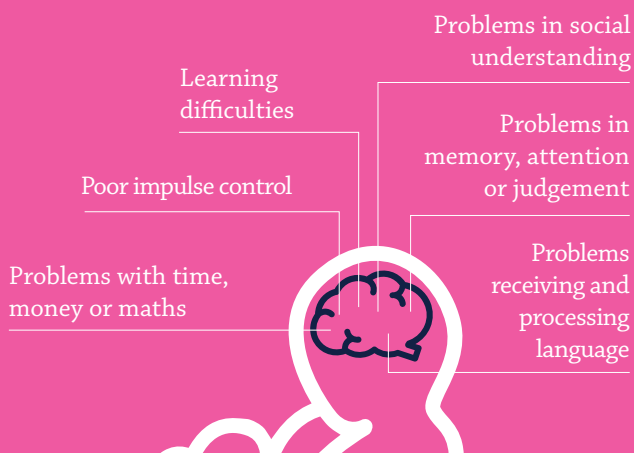
Bone formation defects



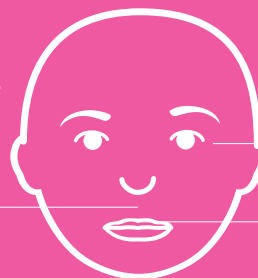
Brain damage
